Students in this program spend their first year in residence at Johns Hopkins School of Public Health completing the Masters of Public Health (https://publichealth.jhu.edu/academics/mph/program-options/) (M.P.H.) component of the joint degree program. The second year is spent at Georgetown completing the LL.M. in National and Global Health Law (https://curriculum.law.georgetown.edu/llm/llm-llm-programs/llmglobal-health-law/), which satisfies the remainder of the M.P.H. degree requirements as well.
